Makwati School which started in 2010 has grown steadily and has now 220 students from kindergarten to Grade 5. Meals are provided for the children on a daily basis with sometimes porridge and sometimes Nshima being the order of the day. Shared Hope is involved in all aspects of the financial requirements of running the school and as the numbers increase on an annual basis so the financial demands increase for the provision of things like school equipment, books, teachers' salaries and food. There is now in place a structure that will enable the development of education in this very needy area at a level that will empower the children who are at the school to have the opportunity to transform their futures in a way that was impossible before this initiative developed.

This school, is overseen by OM Zambia. The head teacher is Mildred Mayini. Mildred's parents started a church in this deprived area but since it became clear that most of those who attended could not read the family decided to start a school. The OM team in Kabwe have, over the last decade, become involved in several community projects in the slums of this city having been motivated by the fact that most of the children did not have the opportunity of going to school. OM have been able to secure financial resource to develop the school buildings and most recently, a new hall has been added to the school.
