Shared Hope's main involvement with Shelter of Hope focuses on the school. There are around 115 children spanning the three pre-school classes and reaching primary 3. There are seven teachers in the school which follows the Kenya government syllabus. The school plans to add on extra classes each year.

The children are provided with a simple meal each day. For many of these children this will be the key meal of the day.

This school has been somewhere that the children from the surrounding slum receive teachings in the basics.

After primary 2 or 3 many of the children then take the opportunity to go to government schools. The quality of the education and commitment of the teachers in many of these schools is not all that it should be which adds to the importance of the solid grounding provided by dedicated staff at Shelter of Hope.

The director of the project is Ishmael Ochieng. Ishmael is a very enthusiastic and innovative young man with a real heart for the poor in the community. This multi-faceted project has been developing over the last few years.

Linked with this project, Ishmael has also established a school in the area of Kenya where he grew up.

He is a leader of a group of churches in Kenya which are steadily growing in number.

Ishmael and his wife went to Zambia some years ago to study at a Bible college there and a church forms part of the overall structure of the project.
