

The school buildings form part of the campus where Daniel and his team carry on their varied ministry. The main school hall is also used as the church on Sundays and when required during the week. There are around 45 orphans who live on the campus and they form part of the school population. In total there are around 220 children in seven classes with a group of committed teachers. This is a rural area but there is a real desire to pursue excellence in the education of these children who come either from very poor backgrounds or who live in the child care home.

When the children reach secondary school age some of them go to the government secondary school which is not too far away and a few who show real academic ability are sent to boarding school. The number going to boarding school is limited by available finance but it is encouraging to see the vision of the leaders to empower capable youngsters from a very poor and rural environment to better themselves as a result of the education they have received.

Daniel Ochieng, who is the founder and driving force in this project, has been heavily engaged over the years, together with a team of men, in planting churches. Together they have planted a significant number of local churches in the last two decades. Daniel, however, has a heart for the practical needs of those in his community and in particular for the widows and orphans.

Daniel has shown himself over the years to be both committed to the community and effective in his efforts.

The location is remote and it is a generally deprived area with little or no economic development.
