This work is located in Hoopi slum, a part of the city of Bangalore, Karnataka. It was started by Peter Ganesh in 2008. The people in this community are poorly educated as well as being materially poor and this project is focused on changing the future prospects of the emerging generation. An excellent school is run in very cramped conditions by six dedicated teachers who are looking after 120 children. The children are extremely enthusiastic committed to learning. They receive a simple meal each day. Linked with the school there is a medical clinic which offers free consultations and medicines to both children and adults. A doctor is employed who gives talks on health and hygiene to the whole community. As well as a school, a children's club runs every Sunday. The team also make home visits helping those who are ill or emotional spiritual facing or ladies problems. The in the community benefit from a tailoring centre and an IT training facility.

Peter Ganesh and his wife, who are South Africans of Indian descent, felt called to establish a work in this very poor Dalit community. Their vision was to work on a holistic basis seeking to meet the educational, practical and spiritual needs of the families who live there.
