There are around 25 children in the home. All but one are girls although the only boy was the first child to be welcomed into the home. The children's ages vary from below school age through to late teens. All the children go to a good school and are progressing well educationally. They receive medical care and counselling. Beulah is trained in these general areas. Beulah's goal is to see that "every deserving child lives a meaningful and purposeful life with dignity." The home, which is run with a Christian ethos, is well equipped and the atmosphere is warm and positive. The children act like one big family and are very supportive of each other.

The home was opened in August 2007 and has developed and grown since then. With the number of children in India, the problem of orphans and abandoned children is huge.
