This project provides living accommodation for approximately 180 children who, as well as being looked after, have the opportunity of a good education in a quality primary and secondary school that is situated less than quarter of a mile from the home. 130 children go to primary school and 50 to secondary school. The home has the capacity to house 350 children but numbers being cared for are determined by available finance. Although run by an ex Moderator of the Presbyterian Church of East Africa, the church has no financial input in this project. A company who are key donors to Shared Hope supported this project over many years and we are happy to continue to provide a measure of support for a project that has been a blessing to many children who have been able to receive a quality education that otherwise would not have been available to them. Very Reverend Bernard Muindi has been an outstanding leader both in the Presbyterian Church and in this very influential educational project.

The leader of the project is the Very Reverend Bernard Muindi who was for six years the Moderator of the Presbyterian Church of East Africa. Bernard is now in his eighties but remains both enthusiastic and energetic in relation to the children's home. The home is linked with a primary and secondary school. While the schools are government run, the school leaders work closely with Bernard.
